## What options were examined?

Many locations were studied and preference was given to property owned by the Diocese. Different locations within the Sudbury region were examined and given careful analysis. Parishes which could benefit from having the offices of the Diocesan Centre at their location were given precedence. After reviewing many options, Holy Redeemer Rectory was selected as the new location for the Diocesan Centre.
